The United States Hispanic Chamber of Commerce supports the nomination of Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson to the Supreme Court

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The United States Hispanic Chamber of Commerce (USHCC) [Board of Directors](#) proudly supports the nomination by President Biden of Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson to the United States Supreme Court and urges the United States Senate to confirm her as soon as possible.

The USHCC actively supports the appointment of Hispanic and diverse candidates who are willing and ready to serve our country. If confirmed, Judge Jackson will be the first Black woman to serve on the United States Supreme Court.

“The American people cannot wait. We urge the U.S. Senate to confirm Judge Ketanji Brown Jackson to the Supreme Court immediately. Her excellence and leadership will deliver equitable justice to America’s more than 63.5 million Latinos/as,” said Ramiro A. Cavazos, President and CEO, USHCC.

A former clerk for Justice Breyer, whom she is nominated to replace, Judge Jackson is a top jurist with strong experience on the federal bench, currently serving on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit.

Judge Jackson has broad experience across the legal profession as a federal appellate judge, a federal district court judge, a member of the U.S. Sentencing Commission, an attorney in private practice, and as a federal public defender. Furthermore, she has been confirmed by the U.S. Senate on a bipartisan basis three times, most recently last year for her current seat.

The United States Hispanic Chamber of Commerce advocates for strong Hispanic and diverse presence at every level of the U.S. Government to accurately reflect the diversity of our nation.

“We are glad that Justice Sonia Sotomayor sits on the Supreme Court and are proud of her leadership.
